**SHORT TITLE:** CDOT TRAINING FOR FLAGPERSONS

**Summary of Legislation**

This bill authorizes the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to certify public and private entities in flagperson training. In addition, the bill requires flagpersons, with the exception of law enforcement personnel, to wear high-visibility clothing, use a prescribed device while directing traffic, and abide by CDOT's manuals for traffic control.

**Assessment**

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill clarifies the authority of CDOT related to flagperson certification training and codifies current practice. The bill does not require CDOT to assume workload or financial responsibilities that do not currently exist.

**Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 27, 2014.
