SHORT TITLE: K-12 ACADEMIC GROWTH PERFORMANCE EVAL 2014-15

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, school district boards of education (local boards) are required to establish an evaluation system for licensed educators that bases at least 50 percent of the educator's annual effectiveness evaluation on student academic growth. For the 2014-15 academic year only, this bill allows a local board to determine what percentage, if any, of the educator's evaluation must be based on student academic growth; however, the percentage may not exceed 50 percent. All other components of the licensed personnel evaluation system in current law must be implemented in the 2014-15 academic year.

Assessment

The bill has no impact on the revenue or expenditures of any state agency, local government, or school district and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 9, 2014.
