Effective Date: The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 11, 2013, and applies to appropriations made on or after July 1, 2013.

Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the Joint Budget Committee, this bill allows the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) to retain any unspent or unencumbered General Fund appropriations for the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) at the end of a fiscal year. Beginning on June 30, 2014, HCPF is required to notify the state controller each June 30 of the amount of the appropriation that should remain available into the next fiscal year. In the absence of additional appropriations, HCPF is authorized to expend only the amount of this "roll-forward" appropriation.

Beginning on January 2, 2015, and each January 2 thereafter, HCPF is required to report to the Joint Budget Committee on the amount of the roll-forward appropriation and the purpose for which the moneys are being used.

State Expenditures

Overall, this bill is anticipated to reduce workload by a minimal amount as a result of reducing the number of supplemental appropriation requests made by HCPF. No adjustments in appropriations are required for either HCPF or the state controller in the Department of Personnel and Administration.
